The 16,000 square foot site is located on 100 acres of pristine, waterfront parkland – surrounded by stately, moss-covered live oak and palm trees. Because of the Club's unique layout and design, with 6,000 square feet of contiguous interior space, it can comfortably host both small meetings of 12 or large dinner dances of 400 guests.

The architectural details of the Ribault Club harken to its Roaring Twenty's origin. The interior's neoclassical, formal style includes 14-foot ceilings, cypress wood French doors, dramatic archways, crown moldings, wainscoting, fluted pilasters, and terrazzo flooring.
